



Connecticut Eviction Filings Data Eviction Filings Trend By Year



Top Client Goals




The **top two** self-reported **client goals** are: **Prevent Eviction Judgment** at 79.5% and **Prevent Involuntary Move** at 81.9%.

So far, 'Prevent Eviction Judgment' was achieved in 75.6% of closed, extensive services cases.

'Prevent Involuntary Move' was achieved in 71.4% of closed, extensive services cases.






Defendant Representation

Statewide




Defendant Representation in RTC Zip Codes

The State of Connecticut created a **Right to Counsel** program **(CT-RTC)** to provide **free legal representation** to income eligible tenants facing eviction or loss of housing subsidy.

The program began in a few communities on January 31, 2022 and will grow over time.
