

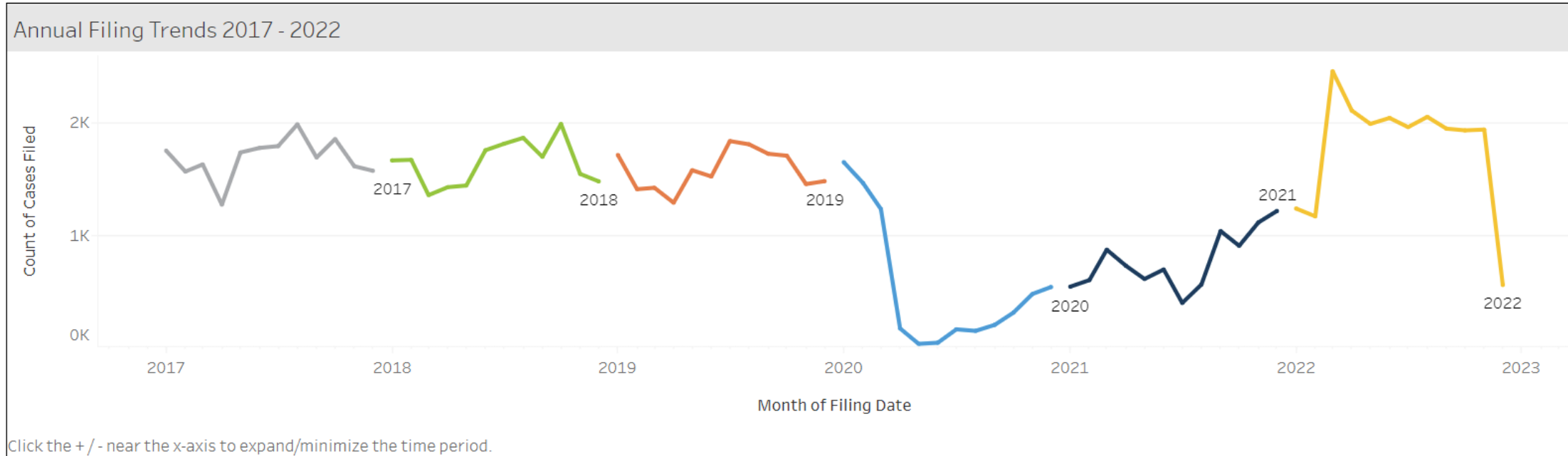

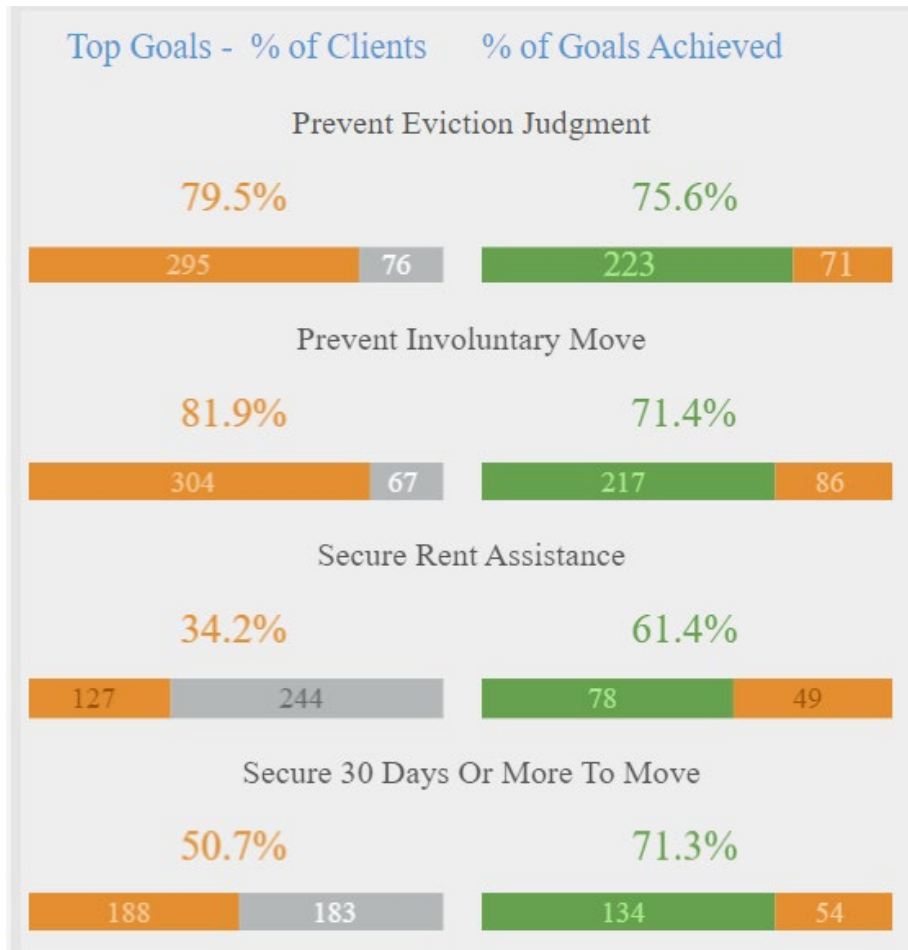

The **top two** self-reported **client goals** are: **Prevent Eviction Judgment** at 79.5% and **Prevent Involuntary Move** at 81.9%.

So far, '**Prevent Eviction Judgment**' was **achieved** in **75.6%** of closed, extensive services cases.

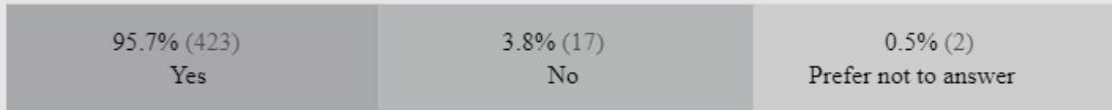
'**Prevent Involuntary Move**' was **achieved** in **71.4%** of closed, extensive services cases.

Informed Landlord Of Conditions

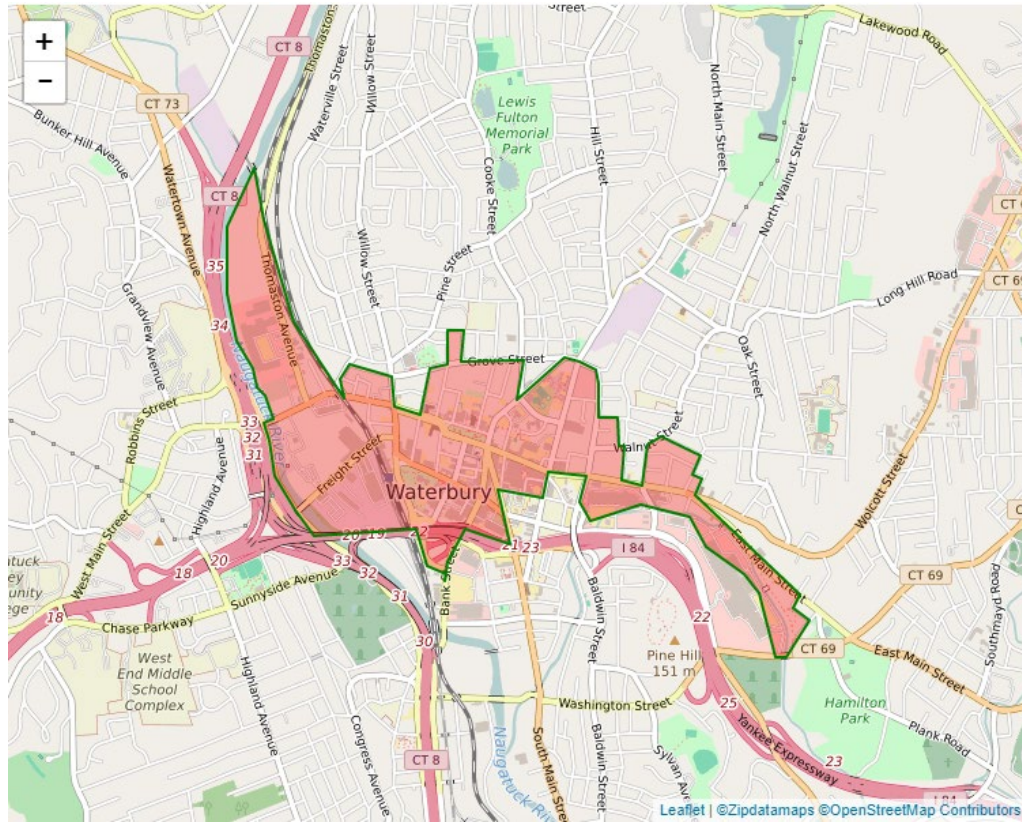

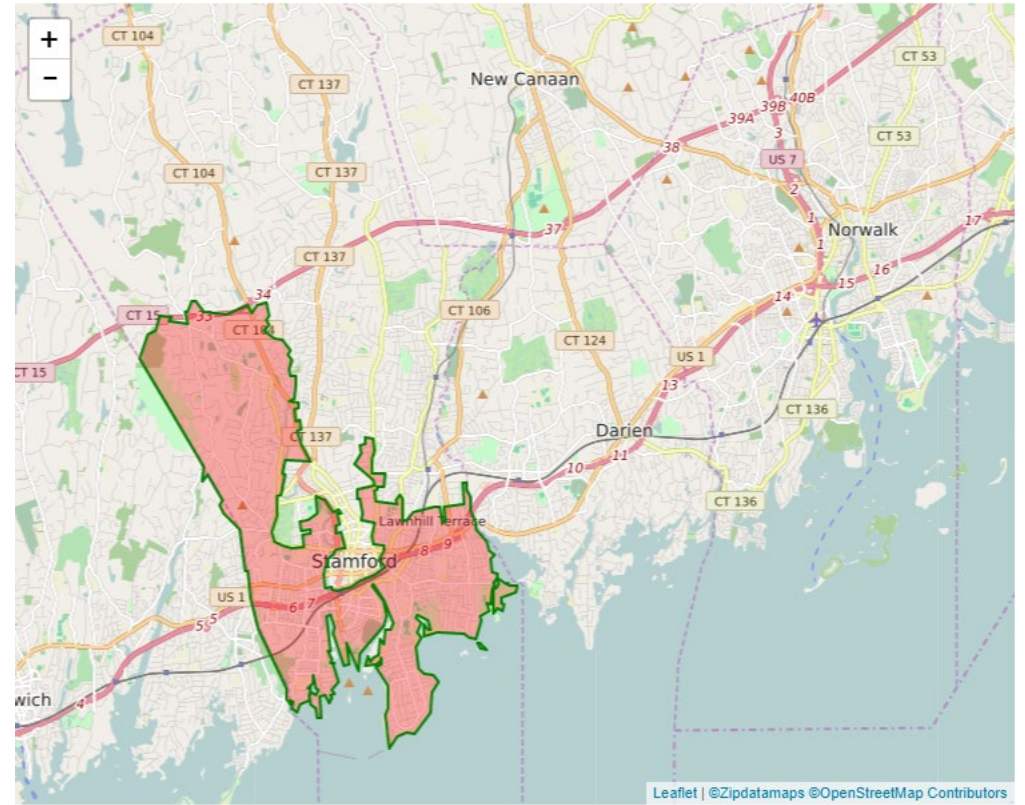

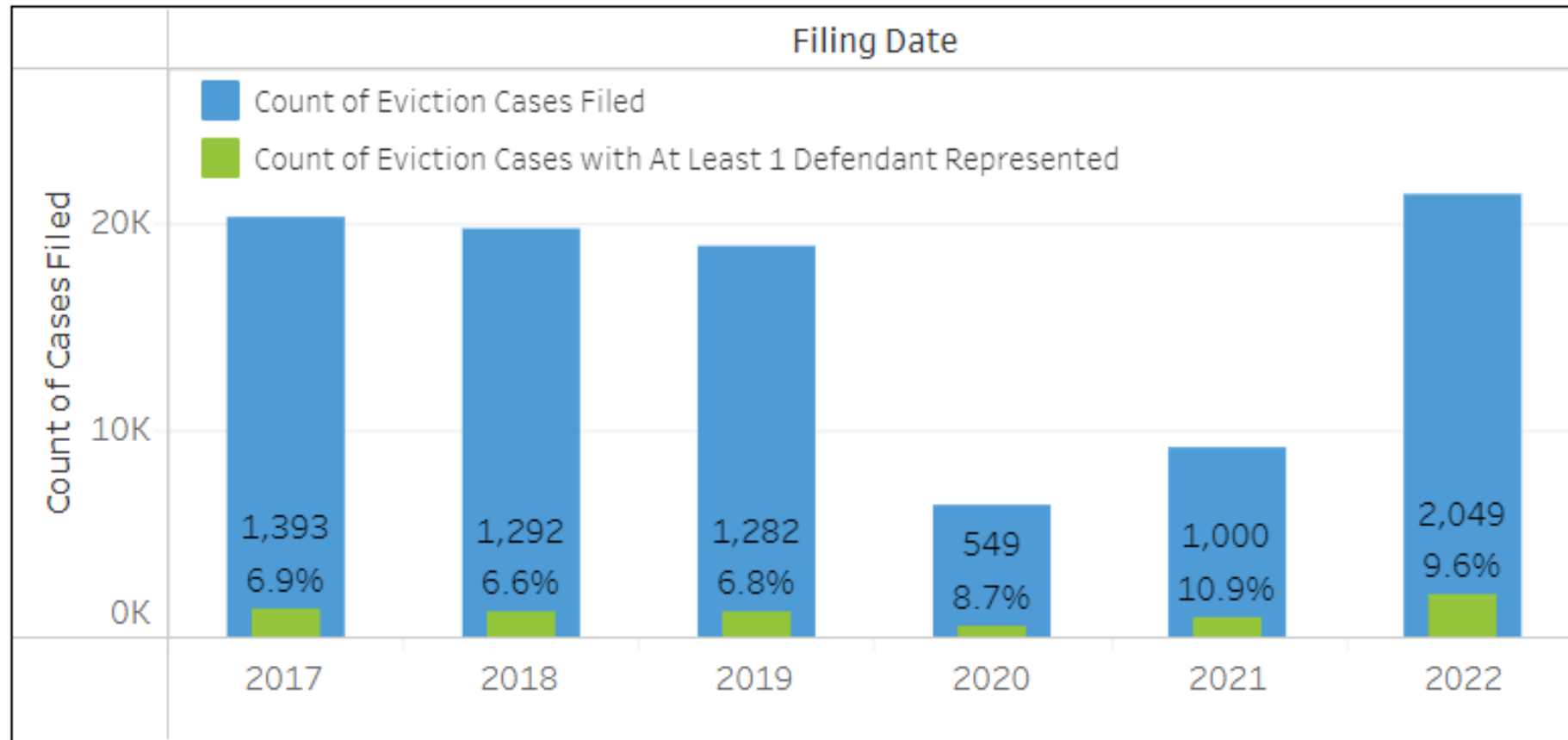

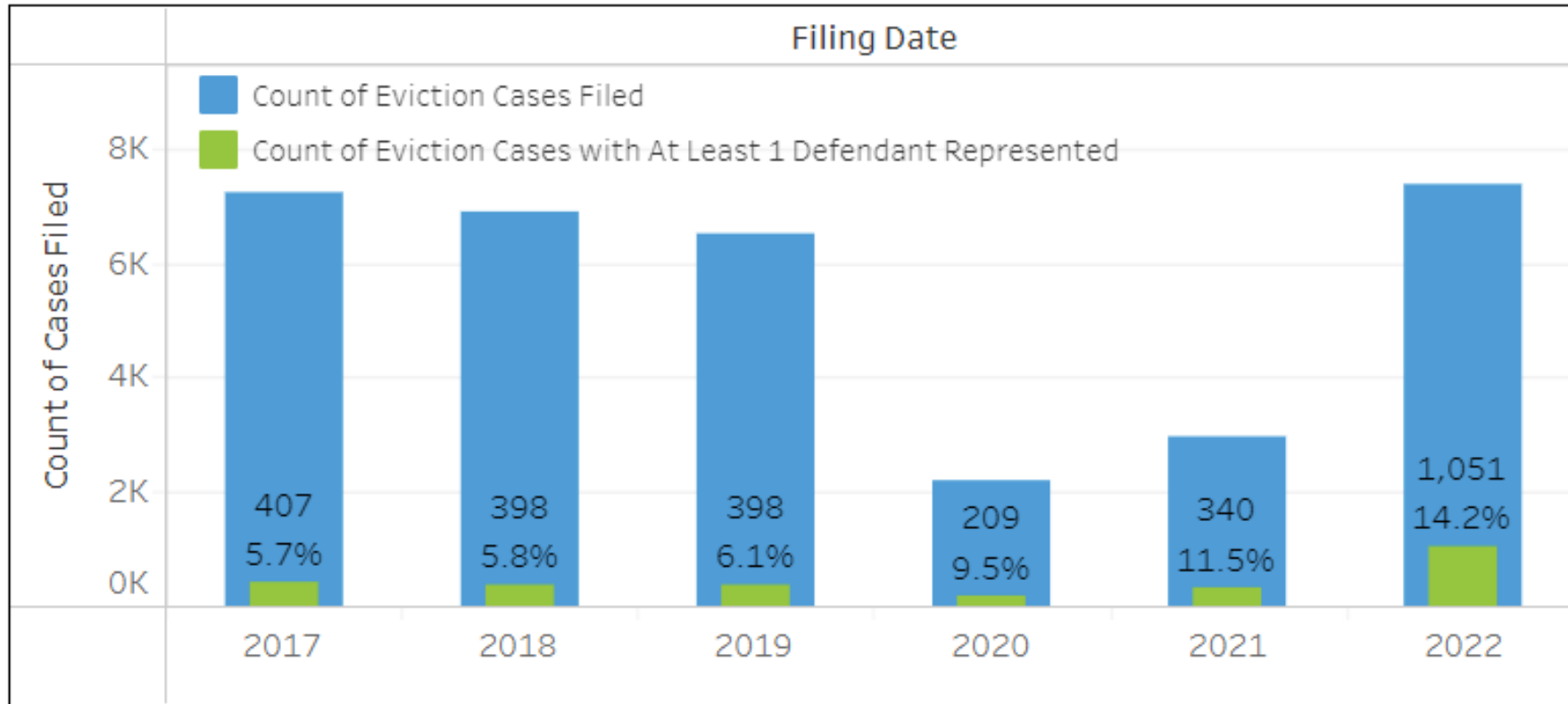

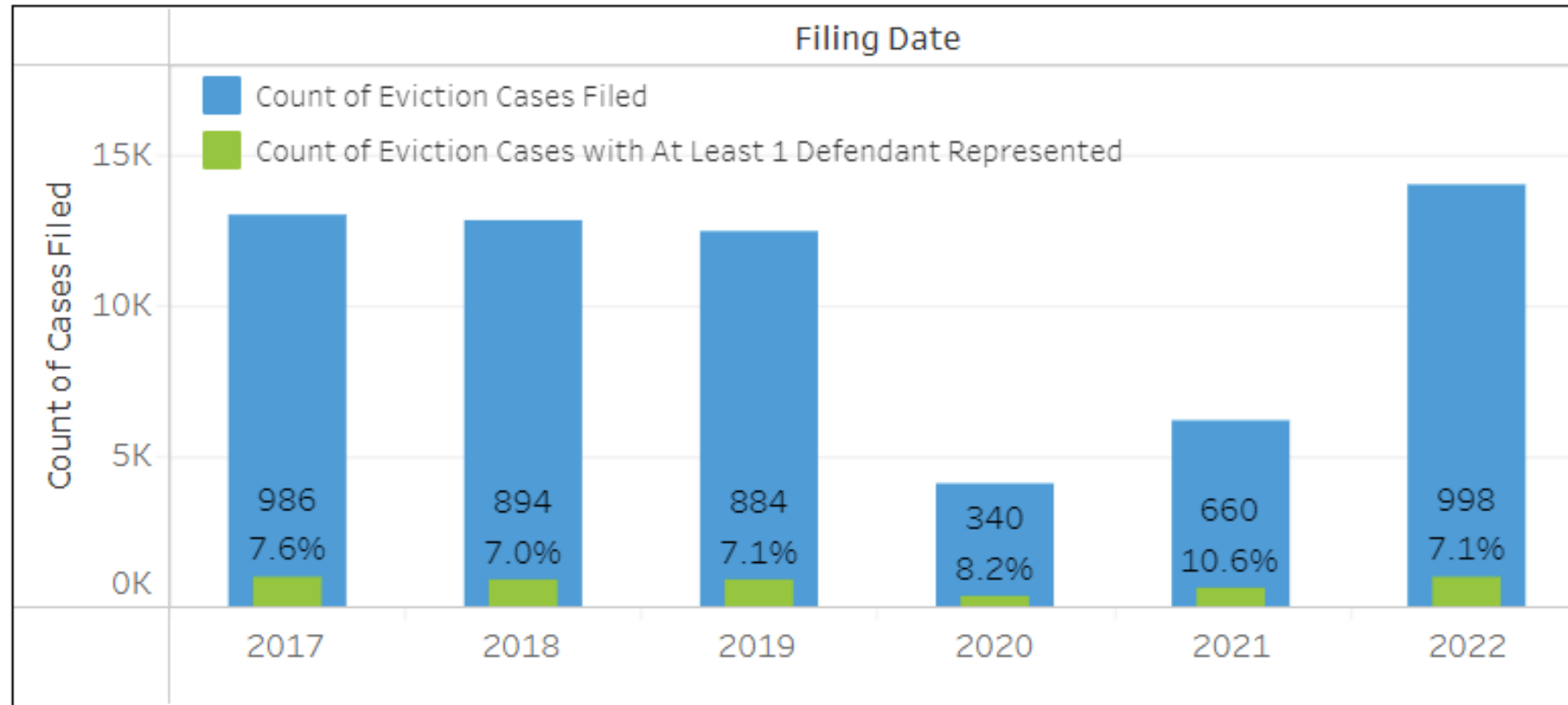
Defendant Representation in RTC Zip Codes
